Beloit/Janesville--- Donald A. Ely, age 85, of Beloit / Janesville died Saturday, April 7, 2007 in Fitchburg, WI. He was born on April 17, 1921, in Janesville and was the son of Alexander White and Mabel (Rose) Ely. Donald graduated from Madison East High School in 1938. He married Mary Louise Frye on September 4, 1940; she died on November 2, 1999. Donald served as a Commissioned Officer in the US Navy in China during WWII from 1944 to 1946. He was an Engineer at Beloit Iron Works, later Beloit Corporation, retiring in 1985. Donald was a member of the Beloit Rotary Club, Saturday Men's Club, Beloit Country Club, and the Roscoe Country Club. He holds 5 United States Patents under his name and an assigned jointly to him through Beloit Corporation.

He is survived by 3 children: Donald A. (Barbara) Ely of Park Ridge, IL, Christine E. (Bradford) Alfery of Evansville, WI and Patricia A. 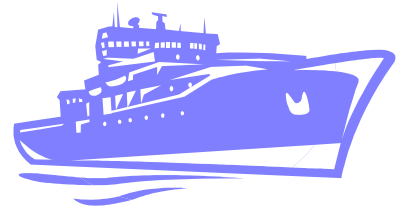

People ON THE *Move*



Rev. Archimandrite Demetri Kantzavelos (97)
The ordination of Bishop-elect V. Rev. Archimandrite Demetri Kantzavelos (97) took place December 9, 2006 at Assumption Greek Orthodox Church.

The Bishop was honored with the reading of two personal letters: one from Mayor Richard M. Daley and the other from Illinois Governor Rod R. Blagojevich.

The following morning, the Bishop presided at his first Hierarchical Divine Liturgy at Annunciation Cathedral.

A native Chicagoan, Bishop Demetrios (Kantzavelos) of Mokinos grew up as an active participant in the Assumption Greek Orthodox Community. He attended Hellenic College and Holy Cross School of Theology in Brookline, Mass., where he obtained his graduate divinity degree in 1987. Following graduation, he pursued post-graduate work in the doctoral philosophy program of Chicago's Loyola University, concentrating in the area of metaphysics.

Having received a monastic tonsure, Bishop Demetrios was ordained to the Diaconate October of 1989. In 1992, he was ordained to the priesthood, and in 1995 elevated to the rank of Archimandrite. Since then, he has served as assistant and Deacon to the bishop, as associate pastor of Annunciation Cathedral of Chicago, and presently as Chancellor of the Metropolis of Chicago.

He was named Outstanding Community Leader by the Cook County Board of Commissioners in 1995, and received the Jim Noone Award for Religious Leadership from the AIDS Pastoral Care Network in 1997. Bishop Demetrios was honored with the Alexian Brothers AIDS Ministry 2005 Presidents Award.

Bishop Demetrios works for justice and humanity in the prison system as a board member, and past two-term President (2003-2005) of the Illinois Coalition to Abolish the Death Penalty.



Ignacio D. Maramba (03)
Attorney, Rotarian and U.S. Army Captain Ignacio D. Maramba (03) recently returned from a 15 day military mission to Baumholder,

Germany, where he served as a Trial Counsel in the Military Justice section of the Staff Judge Advocate for the 1st Armored Division, U. S. Army.

On February 9, at the conclusion of the mission, he received a Certificate of Appreciation from Lieutenant Colonel Karen Fair, Staff Judge Advocate for the 1st Armored Division for exceptional service in the Military Justice section of the Baumholder Legal Center.

Maramba served on active duty in support of the Global War on Terrorism in 2004, and received the United States Meritorious Service Medal in 2006. In civilian life, he is the managing attorney of the Law Offices of Maramba & Associates, LLC, specializing in Employment Law and Business Law. Maramba earned his bachelor's degree and Juris Doctor degree from Loyola University Chicago, and was admitted to the Illinois Bar in 1993.

His ULC involvement includes past service on the Admissions Committee, and he currently serves on the Public Affairs Committee (co-chairing the Judiciary Subcommittee), and as an Officer of the American Legion Post No. 758. He resides with his wife, Jeanmarie, and two daughters, Rachel, 8, and Gwendolyn, 4, in Park Ridge, Ill., where he is also a director and incoming president-elect of the Rotary Club of Park Ridge for 2008-09.



John Scully (87)
One of the newest Civilian Aides to the Secretary of the Army (CASAs) is John Scully (87). He was selected by Acting Secretary of the Army Pete Geren to support the Army throughout their state and local communities.

CASAs were first formally recognized in 1922 and have since become a vital part of the Army. Their mission is to promote good relations between the Army and public by acting as spokespersons for and advisors to the secretary. CASAs are actively involved in their communities and are usually business or civic leaders who bring to their position an interest in the Army.

Scully joined the Army Reserves in 1968 and climbed the ranks to his appointment as the Commanding General of the 102nd U.S. Army Reserve Command. His service has included a tour to Vietnam and Deputy Commanding General of the 86th U.S. Army Reserve Command. He currently serves as the group senior vice president of human resources at LaSalle Bank, and is a member of the Society for Human Resource Management, Human Resources manager Association of Chicago. Scully earned his bachelor's degree from the University of Notre Dame, and his master's degree from DePaul University.

Scully serves as the director of the Armed Forces Council of Chicago and is a member of the Illinois State Chair, USO of Illinois Board of Directors, Employer Support of The Guard and Reserve, Finance Department Advisory Council for DePaul University, and is a Notre Dame Alumni Association director. He has also served as the president of the Notre Dame Club of Chicago, Board of Governors for the Chicago Heart Association and Army Reserve Ambassador. Scully served as ULC Club President from 1999-00.

"It is a great honor to be selected the Civilian Aide to the Secretary of the Army," said Scully.

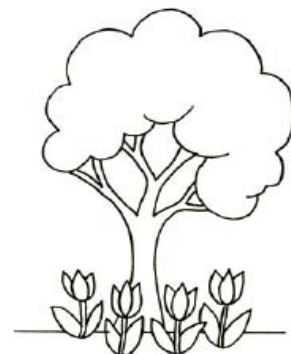
